Dear Occupant or Merchant:

RESTORATION AND IMPROVEMENTS TO CAMBIE STREET

As Canada Line construction finishes on sections of Cambie Street, City of Vancouver crews will be arriving to put on finishing touches north of King Edward through the Cambie Village area. Some of this work is needed to return Cambie to its pre-Canada Line state; other work will further beautify Cambie.

Construction in the Cambie Village commercial area will begin **Monday, April 28**. Many of you have already been advised of this work in discussions with the Cambie Village Business Association, or with a representative from the City of Vancouver.

Work will include:

- Small-scale utility construction across intersections to make room for new traffic signals
- Replacement of curb and gutter (sidewalks will be preserved for access to businesses)
- Installation of new street light bases
- Removal and replacement of sidewalks with tree grates (pedestrians will be detoured in the parking lane with wooden bridges crossing sidewalks to allow business entrance)
- Excavation and repaving of curb lanes to remove deteriorating concrete
- In Cambie Village, installation of pavers on 18th Ave, benches, litter containers, bus shelters, street name plates, hanging baskets, notice boards, bike racks, pedestrian lights, banners and landscaping (Note: Trees may be planted in the fall to increase their chances for survival).

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times and we will do our best to minimize any inconveniences. Parking restrictions will be in effect, however, and there may be traffic delays.

City crews began working between 19th and 23rd on the east side of Cambie in early April. Following work on the east side, work on the west side will be scheduled taking into account timing of events on Cambie. The plan is to begin on the west side at 17th Avenue and proceed south to 24th Avenue.

Work hours will follow the City's Noise Control Bylaw, which allows construction from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm Monday to Saturday, and from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm on Sundays and holidays.
